The Coordination of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education, offered in full association by the Department of Physical Education of UFV and the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports of UFJF, announces that applications will be open for the selection of candidates for the Doctorate Course, on a continuous basis, from **July 11 to November 30, 2024**.

The Postgraduate Program in Physical Education is structured in the Area of Concentration entitled "**Exercise and Sport**", with the following lines of research:

a) Physical activity and health.

Study of the effects of physical activity and sedentary lifestyle in different population groups.

b) Studies of sport and its manifestations.

The study of physiological, sociocultural, historical and psychological aspects and how they affect or are affected by sport.

DOCTORAL SELECTION PROCESS

3. Registration

Selection for the Doctorate in Physical Education will be made through the continuous flow student entry system, with predetermined application and selection periods, and according to the availability of vacancies from advisors.

There will be three selection processes will be planned for 2024, and candidates will only be able to take part in one of them during the year. They will only be able to take part in another process in the same year if their application is rejected (i.e. they fail to take part in the selection process). The themes relating to the lines of research of the intended supervisors and the number of places on offer will be announced from the first day of registration for each period.

Twenty percent (20%) of the total number of places will be reserved for affirmative action. Any vacancies not taken up under the affirmative action scheme will be reallocated to the open competition scheme.

Registration for the selection process will be carried out via the internet on the UFV's postgraduate registration system (GPS) website: <https://gps.ufv.br/gps-web/editais/879/>

Only registrations made online as indicated will be accepted and with payment of the registration fee. The fee must be paid using the boleto that will be generated automatically at the time of registration, and must be paid within one (1) working day of the end of registration. Confirmation of payment is automatically acknowledged in the system itself, but it is advisable to keep the receipt if requested.

Candidates should note that online registration takes place in two stages:

Step 1: Saving the registration: The data is saved in each form launched on the screen. At the end of registration, a completion password will be sent to the registered e-mail address.

Step 2: Finalizing the registration: Entering all the data is mandatory and, once finalized, editing is no longer permitted.

After completing Stage 2, it is important that the candidate accesses their application again and checks the integrity of the documents entered into the system. If you encounter any problems, please contact the Graduate Program Secretariat (ppgefi@ufv.br).

When registering, the candidate must choose one of the modalities, as described below:

1. Broad competition
2. Places reserved for affirmative action
 - 2.1 Black or indigenous candidates;
 - 2.2 People with disabilities.

To apply for the places reserved in Mode 2.1, the candidate must fill in and sign the ethnic-racial self-declaration form, which is available on the online application form, and present themselves to the Commission for the Validation of the Self-Declaration of Black, Brown or Indigenous Candidates, for hetero-identification, in the case of self-declared black and brown candidates, and for verification of supporting documentation, in the case of indigenous candidates, in accordance with the provisions of Resolutions No. 10 of 2018 and No. 8 of 2019.

To apply for the places reserved in Modality 2.2 and 2.3, the candidate must fit into the categories listed in Article 4 of Decree No. 3.298 of 1999 and submit a medical report attesting to the type and degree of disability, with express reference to the corresponding code of the International Classification of Diseases (ICD) and the tests proving their disability, in accordance with the provisions of Resolutions No. 10 of 2018 and No. 8 of 2019. The supporting documentation will be presented to a Disability Assessment Committee, under the terms of Article 4 of Decree No. 3.298 of 1999, which will issue an opinion on the candidate's eligibility or ineligibility for the reserved seat.

The order of presentation to the Committees will be, depending on the case: (i) Self-declaration Validation Committee and (ii) Disability Determination Committee.

The candidate's registration implies knowledge and tacit acceptance of the rules and conditions contained in this notice, in relation to which he/she may not claim ignorance.

People with disabilities must inform the Graduate Program at the time of registration so that accessibility and other conditions that enable them to participate equally in the selection are provided.

Registration periods*:

1st selection schedule: March 15 to 30, 2024.

2nd Selection schedule: July 11 to August 11, 2024.

3rd Selection schedule: November 15 to 30, 2024.

*** Each candidate may participate in only one of the selection schedules.**

- A legible copy of at least one Scientific Article published or a copy of the Acceptance Letter sent by the journal, as author or co-author, in a journal classified as: B2 or higher, in area 21 of CAPES - Physical Education Assessment Area, according to *WebQualis* (2017-2020 Quadrennium); or with an impact factor (JCR) equal to or greater than 1.9; or with a citation index in SCOPUS greater than 25%, until the end of the registration period of this Notice.
- Self-declaration of candidates for places reserved for blacks and browns and indigenous;
- Indigenous Birth Certificate and/or Letter of Recommendation issued by recognized indigenous leader, recognized indigenous elder, indigenous personality of recognized indigenous leader, recognized indigenous elder, indigenous personality of public reputation or indigenous body and/or transcripts issued by a school Memorial of Indigenous Education (description of indigenous educational pathways, indicating the level of appropriation of the indigenous language), in the case of candidates for the vacancies reserved for indigenous people.
- Medical report and supporting exams (with report) carried out in the last 12 months, in the case of months, in the case of candidates for places reserved for people with disabilities.

- Self-declaration of candidates for places reserved for black and indigenous people;
- Indigenous Birth Certificate and/or Letter of Recommendation issued by a recognized indigenous leader, recognized indigenous elder, indigenous personality of recognized public repute or indigenist body and/or School Record issued by an indigenous school; Indigenous Education Memorial (description of indigenous educational pathways, indicating the level of appropriation of the indigenous language), in the case of candidates for places reserved for indigenous people.
- Medical report and supporting exams (with report) carried out in the last 12 months, in the case of candidates for places reserved for people with disabilities.

Exemption from the registration fee:

Applications for exemption from the registration fee must be made on the selection process registration website by the 5th (fifth) registration day of each schedule, attaching a copy of the Single Registry Summary Sheet - V7.

The other rules will be as stipulated in the General Notice of Enrollment in UFV's *Stricto Sensu* Postgraduate Programs:

The UFV will use the terms of article 1 of Decree No. 6.593, of 2/10/2008, for exemption from the registration fee in this Selection Process, and the candidate who is considered exempt will be considered exempt:

a) Is registered in the Federal Government's Single Registry for Social Programs - CAD-Único, as referred to in Decree No. 6.135, of June 26, 2007; and

b) You are a proven member of a low-income family, under the terms of Decree No. 6.135/2007 (monthly per capita family income of up to half a minimum wage, or a family income of up to three minimum wages).

The exemption must be requested at the time of registration directly to the selected Program.

UFV will consult the management body of the CAD-Único to verify the veracity of the information provided by the candidate regarding points a and b. False information will result in the registration being annulled due to fraud and the candidate will bear the legal consequences.

The application for exemption from the registration fee will be evaluated by the Coordinating Committee of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education.

The result of the exemption request will be informed to the candidate on the Program's website (<https://ppgefi.ufv.br/>) and will be available at the secretariat. UFV is not responsible for other forms of publication and/or information on the result.

It is the candidate's sole responsibility to find out the outcome of the exemption.

Candidates who meet the requirements of points a and b and have their exemption request denied may appeal the decision to the Coordinating Committee of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education.

The results of the appeals will be published by the secretariat on the program's website (<https://ppgefi.ufv.br/>).

If the application is rejected, the candidate will have 24 hours to appeal the decision. This request will be re-evaluated and the result will be published by the secretariat on the program's website (<https://ppgefi.ufv.br/>).

If the application is rejected, the candidate will have until the 15th (fifteenth) day of registration of each schedule to proceed with the payment of the aforementioned fee, in a boleto generated on the registration site for the selection process.

Application approval: After analyzing the documentation submitted, the Coordinating Committee of the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education will decide whether to approve the application, and the result will be published on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, within 5 (five) days of the end of the application period. Only applications that meet the requirements of this Notice will be accepted. Applications that are incorrectly filled in or lack mandatory documentation will not be accepted.

4. Board of Examiners

The examining board for the selection process will be made up of two (2) permanent professors from the Graduate Program in Physical Education at UFV/UFJF and will be announced on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, within two (2) days of the end of the application period. If the candidate identifies any link that corrupts the impersonality of the examination board, he/she must file an appeal within 24 hours of its publication. The examining board will evaluate candidates in all stages of the selection process and will respond to appeals filed by candidates after the preliminary results of each stage have been announced.

At all stages, candidates will be identified by an individual code generated after registration, and will no longer be identified by name or CPF.

5. Selection

The selection process will consist of the following stages:

First Stage - Eliminary and Qualifying

Evaluation of the Research Project in written form by an examining board made up of two (2) professors, with a score of 0 to 100 points, eliminatory for a score of less than 70.0 points and classificatory for a score of 70.0 points or more.

The evaluation will be based on the following criteria: 1) Theoretical foundation; 2) Objectives and/or hypotheses; relevance/adequacy of bibliographical references, timetable, financial viability; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; and 4) Suitability of the project to the research lines of the program and the intended advisor (attach a letter to the project clearly explaining this point). Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100.0 points and the final score for this item will be calculated as the arithmetic mean of the scores obtained for each evaluation criterion for each professor. Projects that do not fit in with the research line of the intended supervisor will be disqualified.

The results of the first stage will be published on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br together with the day and time of the individual hearing of those approved for the second stage of the selection process.

Announcement of the results of the first stage: The results of this stage will be published within 14 (fourteen) days of the application being accepted on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br.

Second Stage - Elimination and Classification

Online examination of the Research Project and mastery of topics related to the lines of research of the intended supervisors, with a score of 0 to 100 points, eliminatory for a score of less than 70.0 points and classificatory for a score of 70.0 points or more. It will be carried out by an examining board made up of two (2) professors. Candidates must be available online half an hour before the scheduled time of their hearing and have access to a computer equipped with a camera, microphone and internet connection to ensure their participation in the process without interruption. The candidate must present an original photo ID before the start of this stage.

The hearing will be held via the *google meet* platform. The link to access the online hearing room will be sent by e-mail to the candidate by the advisor chosen during registration.

In the event of a candidate's non-attendance, i.e. if they do not access the online meeting room at the time set for the online examination of their Research Project, they will be disqualified from the selection process. The hearing will be recorded and its storage will be guaranteed.

The candidate will be asked about the following criteria Research Project according to the following criteria: 1) Theoretical basis; 2) Objectives and/or hypotheses; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; 4) Up-to-dateness of bibliographical references; 5) Timetable; 6) Financial viability; 7) Skills and abilities to carry out the proposed Research Project; 8) Adequacy of the project with the research lines of the program and the intended advisor. Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100 points and the final mark for this item will be calculated as the arithmetic mean of the marks obtained for each evaluation criterion.

Announcement of the results of the second stage: The results of this stage will be published within 14 (fourteen) days of the application being accepted on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br.

Third Stage - Qualifying

Assessment of the Curriculum Vitae by an examining board made up of two (2) teachers. The organization of the CV must follow the guidelines described below, Candidates who fail to do so will be disqualified. The

supporting documents must be attached in the same sequence as the Curriculum Vitae. The Curriculum Vitae will be structured and scored according to the following criteria:

1. Training (Total of up to 30.0 points):

- 1.1- Doctorate (30.0 points each).
- 1.2- Master's degree (20.0 points).
- 1.3- Postgraduate Lato Sensu (5.0 points each).
- 1.4- Scientific Initiation Scholarship (5.0 points each).
- 1.5- Monitoring (2.0 points each).
- 1.6- Extension or PET scholarship (3.0 points each).

2. Research Activities - papers published and/or accepted for publication (Total of up to 40.0 points):

Note: Only the last five years will be considered for item 2.

2.1- Scientific articles in indexed journals [10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3 points each, respectively for articles classified in the most current *Webqualis* list; Physical Education Assessment Area (2017-2020 Quadrennium), as A1, A2, A3, A4, B1, B2, B3, B4]. When the candidate is the first author, they will receive a bonus of 50% of the points.

2.2- Full scientific articles in conference proceedings (0.5 points each).

2.3- Abstracts in periodicals and conference/symposium proceedings (0.25 points each, totaling up to 2.0 points).

2.4- Book chapter (4.0 points each, totaling up to 20.0 points).

2.5- Book (10.0 points each, totaling up to 20.0 points).

2.6 - Coordinator of a research group with CNPq certification (5.0 points).

2.7- Undergraduate and/or Specialization Course Conclusion Work (1 point per work, totaling up to 5.0 points).

3. Extension Activities (Total of up to 20.0 points):

3.1- Courses and lectures given (2.0 points each, totaling up to 10.0 points).

3.2- Participation in courses, congresses, symposia, lectures or similar (0.5 points each, totaling up to 10.0 points).

4. Professional Activities (Total of up to 10.0 points):

4.1- Teaching in higher education (1.0 point for every 15 hours, totaling up to 10.0 points).

4.2- Teaching in primary and secondary schools and technical courses (1.0 point per year, totaling up to 5.0 points).

5. Completed Score Sheet - fill in the score sheet in Annex I, at the end of the Notice **(failure to submit this sheet duly completed will disqualify the candidate).**

6. Final Score and Ranking

The final grade will be calculated from the sum of the three stages of the selection process (Stage 1 + Stage 2 + Stage 3) and will be published by name on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, within 14 (fourteen) days of the application being accepted. The final ranking will be from the highest to the lowest score.

- In the event of a tie between two or more candidates, the tie-breaker will be the highest score obtained in the First Stage.
- The list of successful candidates will be made up of the first candidates to fill the vacancies of the advisor indicated on the application form.
- The surplus list will be made up of candidates who have qualified but exceeded the number of places offered by the advisor indicated on the application form.

The Postgraduate Program in Physical Education is not obliged to fill all the places on offer.

7. Registration

The successful candidate must submit his/her documentation for registration and subsequent enrollment after the final ranking has been announced, as soon as requested, to the Postgraduate Department in Physical Education at the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports at UFJF (for successful candidates under the supervision of a teacher linked to their place of work at UFJF) or to the Postgraduate Department in Physical Education at the Department of Physical Education at UFV (for successful candidates under the supervision of

a teacher linked to their place of work at UFV). Any successful candidate who fails to submit the documentation within this period will be considered to have withdrawn and, consequently, the subsequent candidate from the list of surplus candidates per supervisor will be called.

The respective Secretariats will send an e-mail advising those approved on how to deliver/send the documents required for registration. If you have any questions, please send an e-mail to ppg.faefid@ufjf.edu.br (those approved for UFJF advisors) or ppgefi@ufv.br (those approved for UFV advisors).

Candidates on the reserve list, if called by e-mail and/or telephone and/or via the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, must deliver/submit their documents to the Postgraduate Department in Physical Education at the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports at UFJF (for successful candidates under the supervision of a lecturer linked to their place of work at UFJF) or to the Postgraduate Department in Physical Education at the Department of Physical Education at UFV (for successful candidates under the supervision of a lecturer linked to their place of work at UFV).

Candidates will be enrolled once the final results have been announced. The subjects to be taken must be agreed between the candidate and their supervisor. If there are no subjects available until the beginning of the following semester, the student must enroll in "Research".

8. Guide to setting up a research project

Candidates must submit a Research Project that fits in with the research line of the intended advisor (see the Lattes CV of the intended advisor). The Project must follow the following guidelines and be limited to a maximum of 12 (twelve) pages typed on A4 paper, *Times New Roman* font size 12, 1.5 spacing:

- ☐ Project title.
 - ☐ CPF of the candidate, without identifying name.
 - ☐ Name of the supervisor to whom the project will be submitted.

Note: The cover does not count towards the page limit.

Give a brief account of the problem-situation you are addressing, citing data or information that can define its context. Substantiate your defense and line of action/theme (What?; Why?). Present an up-to-date bibliographical review that objectively justifies the implementation of the proposal.



State the objectives to be achieved by the project.

Explain how the stated objectives are to be achieved (subjects, procedures and statistical treatment). In addition, the timetable and financial viability should be described.

List the sources cited in the body of the project.

Note: References do not count towards the page limit. Consider 30 to be the maximum number of references that should be cited in the project. In addition, annexes do not count towards the page limit.

* **Attach a succinct and objective letter** clearly explaining how the project presented fits in with the research lines of the program and the intended advisor. **This document should follow at the end of the project and does not count towards the page limit.** The letter must not contain any identification of the candidate.

3. Report

The PhD course is offered in full association by the Federal University of Viçosa and the Federal University of Juiz de Fora. Thus, the course activities are carried out at both universities, so students must be available to travel between the two institutions, depending on the schedule of activities planned by the coordinator and/or advisor. The doctoral course lasts between 36 and 48 months, unless there are exceptional circumstances provided for in the regulations.

After being admitted, the doctoral student has up to 24 months to take the foreign language proficiency exam, in accordance with the regulations of the respective university to which the student will be enrolled (UFV or UFJF).
